All Extra-curricular Afterschool clubs start next week for those who have signed up. We are also running lunchtime clubs in school that children can access without signing up.



School Spider



How to get started


Once you have selected the school, you will see posts from the school website. Click parent dashboard to login or create an account. Create an account by pressing "create account" and enter your email address.


SHOWING FROM FRI 6 — SUN 8 JAN 2023
