LETTER FOR LENT 2023

Dear All,

As we look forward to March, the sunshine begins to warm the earth after the bareness of winter. There are now beautiful flowers in the garden and the fresh growth of Spring will soon be appearing. This reflects the Easter story – the starkness and coldness of the cross followed by the joy of the Resurrection. Easter may be next month, but we prepare for it this month as well.

The hymn, by Stuart Townend, captures the cost of God's love for each and everyone of us. Jesus stands at the door and knocks on the door of every life. And when we open the door we are met with a love and peace beyond our understanding and which we don't deserve. This is the heart of the Christian message, and Lent is the time for coming to God afresh, opening the door and welcoming God into our lives. Our God's arms are outstretched to welcome us home.


Bishop Gill will be confirming those candidates who have completed the confirmation course on 25th June at 5pm in Christ Church Wesham.


Treales Church has been invited to join with Wesham Church and Warton Church for this service of Confirmation.
