


#### **Sponsored walk**

The Rt Rev Philip North and The Rev Sam Cheesman hope that you might sponsor them as they plan to walk 100km across Lancashire in just one weekend in aid of the people of Liwolo in South Sudan.

As part of the Bishop's Harvest Appeal this year the Bishop of Blackburn and Bishop's Chaplain plan to walk 100km starting the evening of Friday 15 September, finishing back at Bishop's House on Sunday 17 September.

They hope to go through and pray in as many Deaneries as possible in this time, remembering the people of the



parishes there as well as those who are in refugee camps in Northern Uganda as they have fled the civil war in South Sudan.

Their aim is to raise as much money as possible to support the work of Bishop Joseph Aba who is the Bishop of Liwolo, a Diocese still in exile but with the hope to return home soon.



The people he serves there have been referred to as 'the poorest people in the world' and face an extremely uncertain future as they look to rebuild all that was lost in the war.

#### **HIGHWAY MATTERS**

#### **Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic order 2023**

ROSEACRE ROAD at SASWICK will be closed Monday 9th October 8a.m until Friday 13th October 5pm to allow water connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities. An alternative route is via Inskip Rd - Higham Side Rd - Preston Rd - Lodge Lane.

The Parish Council has asked LCC to consider what action the Parish Council and County Highways Department could do to encourage speed reduction and has requested that the speed limit be reduced to 40mph in certain areas. We await their reply.

In order for LCC and the Police to consider our request for speed reduction measures we have to provide detailed evidence. It is vital therefore to report whatever you witness as follows:

- Speed concerns and general incidents of inconsiderate driving. Report online to Lancashire Road Safety Partnership on <u>lancsroadsafetypartnership.co.uk</u>. Then report same incident as detailed below.
- General incidents of inconsiderate driving, near misses, mobile phone
  use etc. Report directly via phone to 101 or email
  <u>Kirkham.NPT@lancashirepolice.uk</u> giving details including date, time
  and location.
- Collisions, vehicles through hedges etc. Report via phone to 101 or via email to <u>accident.clerks@lancashirepolice.uk</u> Giving details including date, time and location.

#### **80TH ANNIVERSARY D-DAY 6TH JUNE 2024**

The Parish Council will be considering how to mark the occasion and join in nationally planned celebrations of the day which led to the liberation of France and Western Europe and is considered to be one of the most significant battles in history.

It would be valuable to hear from anyone with memories/stories/ photographs of life in or around the Parish during WW2 particularly as it was involved via:

 HMS Nightjar (now siting the large aerials Wharles and Roseacre) purpose built airfield for the admiralty and commissioned in May 1943 was closed to flying from February 1946

- RAF Kirkham 1940-1957
- Weeton army camp was used by RAF as a training base WW2
- RAF Squires Gate

The Parish Council will also consider whether to plant poppy seeds around the Parish in tribute to all those who gave their lives fighting for our country.
